About Fort Mason Center for Arts & Culture

Founded in 1977, Fort Mason Center for Arts & Culture (FMCAC) is an arts and culture nonprofit operating within a Historic Landmark District along San Francisco’s northern waterfront. Part of the Golden Gate National Recreation Area, FMCAC hosts an ever-evolving rotation of arts and cultural programming for over 1.2 million annual visitors, including theater and dance performances, art installations, and educational and cultural classes.

As part of its commitment to supporting San Francisco’s artistic community, FMCAC provides \$2.5 million in annual grants to local arts organizations. These grants allow groups to produce diverse and innovative works on the historic campus. In addition to the thousands of events that occur each year on campus, FMCAC is home to nearly two dozen nonprofit and arts organizations.

A pioneer in the reuse of military bases, FMCAC has been honored by the National Trust for Historic Preservation and the California Preservation Foundation for its efforts to preserve and adaptively reuse the historic U.S. Army San Francisco Port of Embarkation.
